I MOOT PROBLEM

Pineapple State is situated in Banana Country. The Laws, geography, economic and political systems are similar to that of India. In Pineapple State, the Governor promulgates same ordinance multiple times over a period of five years. The impact of this Ordinance was to take over the private school employees by the Pineapple State. Thereafter as the Ordinances 'Cease to operate', the impacted employees were not considered for the entitlements applicable to government employees.
